

## **Artistic Innovations Grants**

Purpose: Nurture and sustain artists and arts-based organizations of all disciplines in their new creative endeavors

- Grants up to \$15,000 for arts organizations or individual artists
- Up to 50% of total expense
- Artists can match with in-kind
- Annual deadline just passed
- Guidelines available again in the fall



### **Regional Touring Program Grants**

- Purpose: Support presenters to bring in regional artists from outside their home state
- 50% of artist fees up to \$5,000 for SAA roster artists
- 25% of artist fees up to \$5,000 for non-roster artists
- An additional 10% for rural communities
- Artists of any discipline
- Quarterly deadlines—next up: Feb. 1 for April–June 2015 activities
